

Using CatTrack Litters on eCat

1

eCat litters registered after June 19, 2024 use a new process for the kittens in a litter called CatTrack.

CatTrack ID's are assigned to each available kitten on a litter. Think of them as the individual registration slips for each kitten.


Each CatTrack ID has to be filled out before it can be used to register a kitten. This is like filling out the application slip you would give to a new owner, which would contain the color, sex, coat length....etc..

Because you are setting up the kitten's information first, you no longer need to lookup and provide a PIN number if you are granting them breeding rights.

The below steps walk you through using CatTrack to setup a kitten for registration. You do not need to setup all of the kittens in the litter at the same time.

Click "Manage Litters"

On a CatTrack litter you will have an option to download the litter certificate or manage CatTrack. On older litters before CatTrack was launched, you will have the options to download the Blue or Yellow Slip applications.

For this CatTrack litter you will click "Manage CatTrack" .

A kitten available for registration will have a red status of "Setup Required".

A kitten that has been setup will have a blue status of "Available".

Click the "Yes" or "No" for breeding rights.

This means you no longer need a PIN number.

When the cat is registered, we will already know if the cat should be "For Breeding".

After making all the selections, click "Save". This will make the cat available to be registered.


11 From the **"Actions"** you can:

1. **Email the registration application directly to the new owner.**

2. **Register the cat for the new owner or to yourself.**

3. **Download the registration PDF application to hand to the new owner.**

The application will contain the litter number and the CatTrack ID number for the cat. When the new owner enters that litter number and CatTrack ID, the system will automatically know the Sex, Coat Length, Color, and Breeding Rights which apply to the cat.
